# **ABOUT THE AWARD**

REAAA NZ have held the Low Volume Roads Workshops in New Zealand every two years since 2003. Every one of those has been successful and REAAA want to reinvest some of the proceeds in this award.

The Award provides the opportunity for REAAA NZ members to develop the skills and expertise necessary to enhance their senior management or industry leadership capability. The award is to cover the full costs, other than salary, for the winner to attend the 12th TRB International Conference on Low Volume Roads to be held in about July 2019 at Kalispell, Montana. The award will also contribute to the cost of a study tour of up to 10 days in the USA either before or after that Conference. The award is to a maximum value of \$NZ10,000.

# **CONTENT OF APPLICATION**

- A curriculum vitae (tailored CV to confirm roles, responsibilities and professional development)
- Two written references in support of the application (referees may be contacted).
- Maximum 300 word statement on why you should attend the course, and how it will benefit you and your employer.
- Provide information on study tour options

## **JUDGING CRITERIA**

You will:

- Be a future industry leader and recognised by your peers as making or capable of making an outstanding contribution to the community and your profession
- Have a qualification in engineering, technology, or science
- Be a good ambassador for Low Volume Roads in NZ.
- Present a written and verbal presentation to the judging panel comprised of REAAA and LVR committee representatives

### **CONDITIONS**

- Applicants must be a current member of REAAA NZ and be employed full-time in a road controlling authority, consultant or contractor working on low volume roads.
- Applicants must be available to attend the International Low Volume Roads Conference.
- The successful applicant is to present to the 2019 REAAA LVR Workshop and the 2019 REAAA Roadshow identifying key learnings from the Conference and Study Tour.
- The award includes the cost of up to \$NZ10,000 of attending the conference and the cost of any travel and overnight accommodation on the approved Study Tour.
